City of Globe Election Information

The City of Globe holds council elections in the fall of even-numbered years. Other elections may be called on an as needed basis.

- 2020 Primary Election will be held on August 4, 2020
- 2020 General Election will be held on November 3, 2020

The City Council is a seven-member non-partisan body. The City of Globe has adopted the district system of elections, a qualified elector may vote for only one councilmember to represent their district; however, all qualified electors vote for Mayor.

Note: Only registered voters living within City limits are eligible to vote in local elections.

Candidate packets are now available. Packets may be obtained at the City Clerk's Office, 150 N. Broad Street, Globe, Arizona, 85501, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Nomination papers may be filed with the City Clerk no earlier than March 9, 2020 and no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 6, 2020.

A candidate for local office must be a qualified elector at the time of filing their nomination paper. Any such candidate must be 18 years of age or older. A candidate must be able to speak, write and read the English language. Candidates must also have resided in the Globe city limits for at least one year and within their district for at least one year preceding the election.
