ORDINANCE NO. 837 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GLOBE, COUNTY OF GILA, STATE OF ARIZONA, AMENDING THE GLOBE CITY CODE BY AMENDING CHAPTER 7 AND ADDING SECTION 7-1-14 PROHIBITION OF UNSUPERVISED OUTDOOR FEEDING OF FERAL AND STRAY DOMESTIC ANIMALS ALSO INCLUDING, WILD ANIMALS; REPEALING ANY AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.


