Vendor Contract - Rules and Regulations

Booth Information

Size: 10 x 10

Amenities: Vendors must supply their own chairs, tables, etc. Food booths should consider providing tables and chairs for your customers to be placed directly in front of your booth area. You are also responsible to keep this area clean and free of trash and debris.

Safety: No liquor, firearms, knives, drugs fireworks “poppers”, bomb bags, lighters or any inappropriate items will be allowed for sale. Any booth selling those items or similar items will be asked to remove them from their displays. If the booth holder continues to sell these or similar items, the booth holder will be asked to remove his/her booth and will forfeit the booth fees. Food booths MUST have at least one fire extinguisher with rating 2A10BC. All vendors are responsible for having heavy duty electrical cords capable of handling the loads necessary if electricity will be used.

Food Booths: Must be in compliance with Gila County food handling rules and regulations for special events. Please review attachment - (For food booth applications ONLY) Call Gila County Division of Health and Human Services, Environmental Service Unit: 1-800-304-4452 x 8517 for additional information. Food Handler card must be displayed and a copy sent in with application.

Setup/ Vendors will be allowed to set up beginning at 7 am on May 5th and must be finished by 9 am for health and fire inspection.

Contract: To be registered, the vendor MUST return both the Vendor’s Contract signed, a Copy of their Food Handlers Card from Gila County, and all applicable fees paid in full to The City of Globe. All applications must be received no later than Monday, April 30, 2012.
