
Re: Photo Enforcement

I have reviewed reports generated by Redflex for the months of October and November and our department accident reports to continue to determine how effective our photo enforcement program is doing in reducing red light and speed violations and also accidents. The attached accident graph and spread sheet show that there has been a reduction in accidents at the fix enforcement locations from prior years of this same time period. The data comparisons are for the months of May through November (months photo enforcement has been active) for years 2005 through 2011. The information from Redflex shows that there has also been a continued reduction in speed violations at our fixed locations. There was a slight increase in red light violations in the months of October and November, but these numbers are still lower than May through August of this year (see attached graph). I have also been informed that the photo enforcement program is not costing the city money and is running in the black.

There was an accident involving injuries at the 60/188 Junction that occurred on December 1, 2011. There were no witnesses that came forward and the case became a he said she said investigation. We were able to review the photo enforcement video and determine who was the violator in this accident. I feel that this not only reduced our investigation time, but could keep the officer from having to argue the case in court or at least shorten the time spent in court. This gives the officer more time to patrol the streets or complete other duties of more importance.

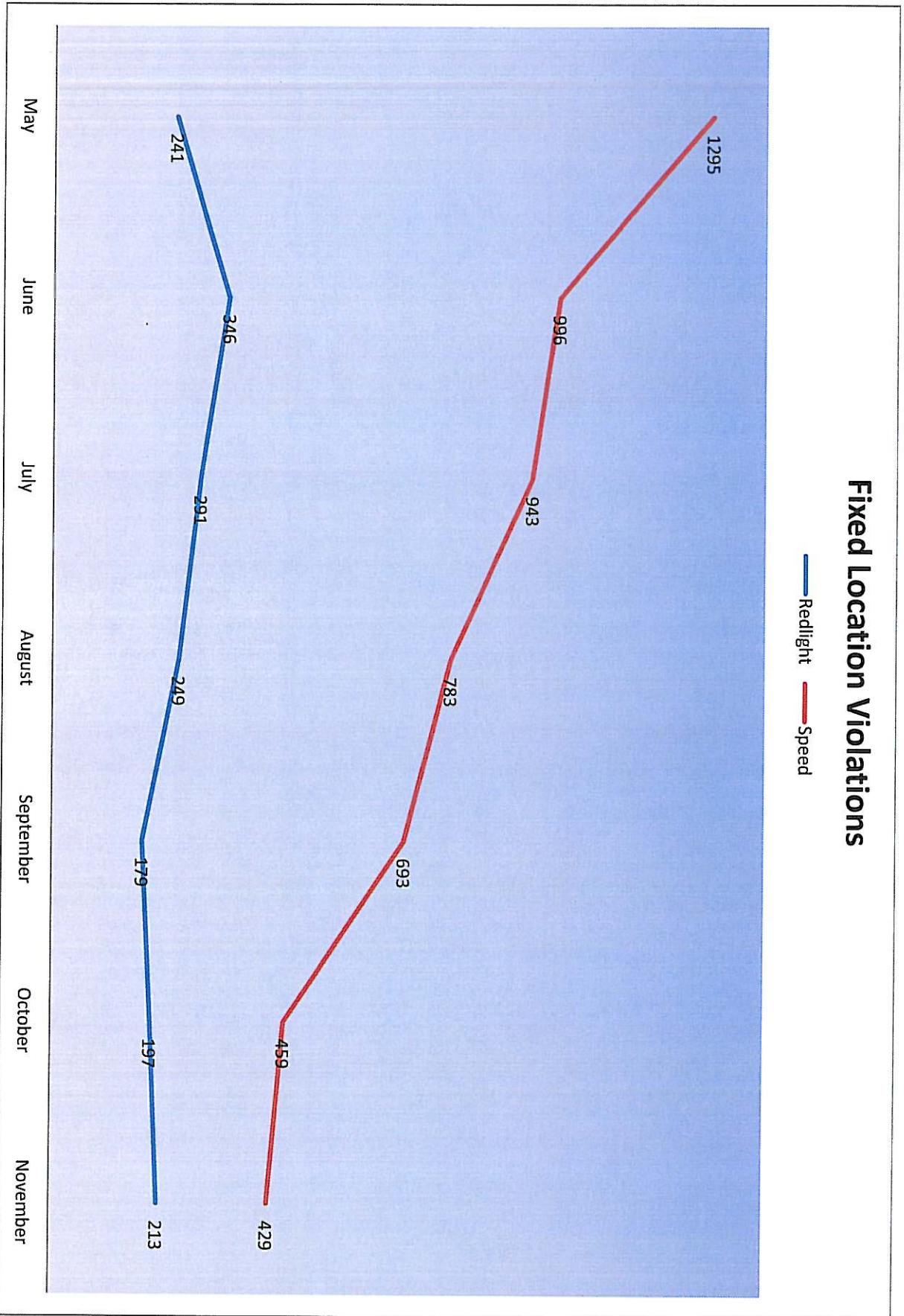
With this information I feel that we are continuing to receive the desired results from our photo enforcement program.

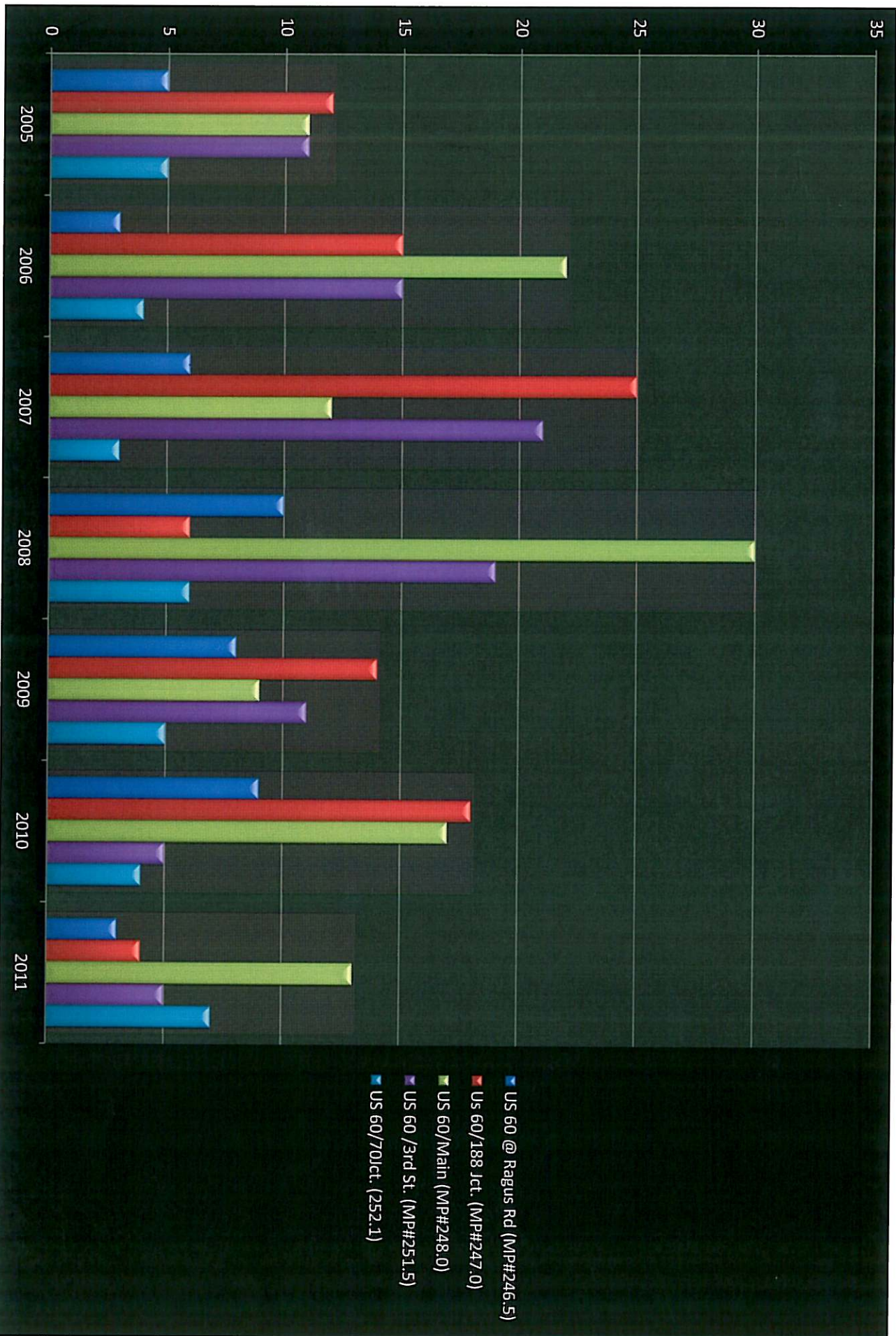
